Household Hazardous Waste — Our annual Household Hazardous Waste Disposal event will be held from 8 a.m. to noon on June 15. This year's event will be held in the parking lot of Harrisonville High School — 1504 E Elm Street.

- · All paints
- Automotive fluids (motor oil, antifreeze, etc.)
- Cleaners
- Lawn and garden products
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Batteries
- Nail polish
- Fluorescent lightbulbs
- Cooking oil
- Pesticides/insecticides
- Pool chemicals
- Any items containing mercury

Harrisonville residents can also access the permanent facilities in Lee's Summit and Kansas City and also can attend any of the mobile events scheduled April through October.

<u>Outdoor Pool opening soon!</u> — Opening day for the 2024 Outdoor Pool season will be **Friday, May 24**.



**Hours:** The Outdoor Pool is open from noon to 7 p.m. Monday to Thursday, with Family Swim from 5 p.m. until close. From Friday to Sunday, the pool is open from noon to 6.

Admission: Season passes can be purchased at the Harrisonville Community Center. A Family Pass will cost \$175. An Adult Pass will cost \$100. A Senior Pass will cost \$80. A Youth Pass will cost \$80. A day pass will cost \$7 for registered guests.
